Research: TSE is one of the world's top economics departments, gathering more than 150 international faculty among whom Jean Tirole, 2014 Nobel laureate. Over the years, TSE has consolidated its reputation as one of the top institutions in Europe, today ranking among the top 3 beneficiaries in economics of the prestigious European Research Council (ERC) grants. On the wider scale, TSE today ranks 10th economics department worldwide according to the RePEc ranking. TSE is particularly renowned for its scientific contributions in industrial organization, finance, energy and climate economics, and econometrics.

Education: Since 2011, TSE has been training tomorrow's top economists by offering multidisciplinary undergraduate, Master's, PhD and Executive Education programs. Its 2500 students benefit from the academic excellence of TSE faculty but also from the inputs and advice of international experts. Our alumni are employed in a wide range of national and international organizations, in government, international institutions, business and finance.

Interdisciplinarity: The Institute for Advanced Study in Toulouse (IAST) is TSE's sister institution, a cutting-edge research center aiming at unlocking solutions to today's major issues through analytical and quantitative methods across the social sciences. IAST's cross-frontier scientific program brings anthropologists, biologists, economists, historians, lawyers, mathematicians, philosophers, political scientists, psychologists and sociologists around questions of leadership, power and inequality, social evolution, the evolution of technology and expanded morality.

Partnerships: Jean-Jacques Laffont, TSE's founding father, always envisioned a strong link between academics, institutions and companies. Partnership research opens new avenues for research and actively contributes to the dissemination of economic knowledge to decision-makers. Partnerships are today more than ever a driving force in the development of TSE.

While TSE's unique atmosphere is hard to define, there is a palpable sense of a "TSE- style economics". Based on a broad range of academic interests and a deep sense of curiosity, open mindedness and an engrained culture of collaborative work, our approach is coupled with an appetite for tackling real-world problems and generating deployable policy solutions.

Building on a tradition of interactions with decision-makers

Toulouse economists have developed a model that brings academic research at the highest level to focus on real-world issues, through interactive dialogue with industrial partners and policy-makers.

Over the years, TSE partners have benefited from the economic expertise of TSE faculty in a wide range of fields. The exchanges with partners have also been of great help to TSE faculty who have been able to test their theories, models, and predictions. The work that the Nobel Committee rewarded Jean Tirole for in 2014 stems from this tradition of partnership research.

Solving key economic and social issues

TSE's research partnerships are grouped into six thematic centers. These centers host and foster interactions with a wide range of public and private partners, whether businesses, governmental and regulatory institutions, NGOs, or not-for-profit organizations, from France and worldwide. They provide a favorable context for the development of targeted research projects directly connected to society concerns and economic actors. They also aim at bringing academic insights to practitioners and anchoring TSE's scientific expertise in the public debate, through a wide range of outreach initiatives.

A wide range of partnership solutions

TSE partners can support research within a specific scientific project – a research initiative or a chair – and/or contribute to the long-running operations of one or more TSE Centers. Many research programs are undertaken across several different centers – such as digital & health – and include a multidisciplinary approach.

TSE donors and project sponsors provide funding to encourage the set-up of leading teams on emerging research issues, as well as funding for visiting programs, research grants and scholarships. In addition to financial support, TSE researchers value the provision of databases they can use.
