The school will focus on the public policies that support the transition to a greener energy mix. The lectures will examine the emergence, design and impacts of those public policies including carbon trades, cap-andtrade, emission standards, subsidies to R&D, feed-in tariffs and renewable portfolio standards, intellectual property rights for green innovations. Both theoretical and empirical approaches will be covered. We offer a one week (five working days) of study program for PhD students and Postdocs, which is composed of morning courses and afternoon paper presentations.
