

# Solving key economic and social issues



TSE has set up various research centers with the aim of encouraging, coordinating and supporting research activities on **priority topics** that are relevant for economic actors and for the society more broadly. They bring together academics from all TSE and IAST research groups and experts from the corporate world. As of today, three centers have been developed: the TSE **Digital** Center, the TSE **Energy & Climate** Center, and the TSE **Sustainable Finance** Center.

► Your support will allow us to offer **a grant for a young researcher** in one of the fields covered by the centers. The grant will be made available, on a priority basis, to **PhD students** in their last or antepenultimate year of PhD, or to researchers at an early stage of their career.

# Optimize our environment to foster innovation

TSE's current urban campus at the historic Manufacture des Tabacs is becoming a little small for our growing faculty. In 2019, we are delighted to be moving our research department to a **brand new architectural edifice** in the historical heart of Toulouse. This vast new building will provide an inspirational backdrop, and also an **innovative high-tech lab for carrying out behavioral & experimental research**.

## Help us equip a new lab to the highest standards

Equipment or software from 500€ to 5,000€

► While the funding of the basic structure is in place, we seek additional resources to **purchase equipment and software licenses for the lab**. This lab will initially be equipped with a set of interconnected computers on which participants can be tested simultaneously with real-time interactions.

“My main research interest concerns the influence of emotions and psychological traits on economic decision making and behavior. I use economic laboratory experiments and combine these with psychological methods for measuring emotions and character traits. The future TSE/IAST laboratory will be a great resource not only for my own work but also for many of my colleagues. We aim to build a state-of-the-art facility that will enable us to conduct a wide range of different types of research. From classical laboratory studies on financial markets, auctions and games, to experiments involving emotion measures, eye-tracking and physiological arousal of participants. ”
