John Vickers is a professor of economics at the University of Oxford and the Warden of All Souls College. Previously he was Drummond Professor of Political Economy at Oxford, chief economist at the Bank of England and a member of the Monetary Policy Committee, head of the Office of Fair Trading, and chair of the UK's Independent Commission on Banking. His research interests mainly concern competition and regulation, including the theory of industrial organization and policy questions in antitrust and banking regulation.

Ekaterina Zhuravskaya is a professor of economics at Paris School of Economics and EHESS. She received her PhD in Economics from Harvard University in 1999. She is a Research Fellow of the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) in Public Policy and development economics programs. She spent 10 years working as professor of economics at the New Economic School and as the Academic Director of the Center for Economic and Financial Research (CEFIR). Her primary field of interest is political economics with applications to media, ethnic conflict, culture, corruption, and economic history. Ekaterina was awarded the CNRS Silver Medal and the Birgit Grodal Award.
