#### 1. Innovation:

Describe the degree of innovation of your idea.

<p>Innovation should be interpreted in a broad sense. It can be the application of an innovation (e.g., policy strategy) already realized or implemented in another sector/industry/firm.</p>	
<p><b>2. Implementation feasibility and economic impact</b> Describe or use a simple illustrative calculation to demonstrate the feasibility and the economic impact of the idea. Investment costs, eventual generated revenues/ cost savings.</p>	
<p><b>3. Impact</b> What is the climate impact of the idea? Who does it target? What is the indirect impact, if any? Does the idea generate systematic change in its target industries / sectors?</p>	
<p><b>4. Scalability</b> How is it scalable / replicable? Indicate the number of people / stakeholders who would be affected by this innovation. Are there any potential impediments for scalability?</p>
