



MISSIONS OF THE STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

Students in L3, M1 and M2 elect their representatives directly. There are two student representatives for each academic path.

For the L1 and L2 years, program directors designate a group of voluntary students: two from the Economics & Management program, two from the Economics program, two from the Economics & Law program, two from the Economics & Mathematics program.

Student representatives' main missions are to relay information concerning lectures and tutorials throughout the semester either to the teacher in charge of the course, to the teacher in charge of the diploma (or year) or to the Undergraduate or Masters' Program Directors.

The representatives actively take part in biannual meetings with the academic coordinators and the school board in order to assess lectures and tutorials for one particular semester. During this meeting, the school board will review the actions taken since the last biannual meetings. A report transcribing what was said and decided during the meeting will be signed by the directors as well as the delegates before being saved for the school archives.

Each student representative must sign a charter summing up the missions and duties of a delegate.

The dates of the meetings with the school board are yet to be confirmed but should take place during the week of 21st November.

Please note that the representatives must respect the confidentiality of the information sent to them.
