# INTERVIEW

#### Where do you work and which position do you hold within Google?

As a Trust & Safety Analyst at Google I work on defending the integrity of Google products, its users and partners worldwide by defining and communicating product policies, fighting spam, fraud, and abuse across Google products.

## Can you tell us briefly what you do and which skills acquired during your master's degree at TSE do you use?

The most useful skills I acquired during my master's degree are: Statistical Analysis, Data Mining, Programming, Data Bases and SQL. I particularly value the apprenticeship and work at Air France during the last year of my studies. It gave me not only great professional experience but also allowed me to improve my time management skills. CAREER AND ACADEMIC PATH

Anna holds a Master in Statistics & Econometrics from TSE and a bachelor in Applied Mathematics and Social Sciences from the University of Lyon 1. She has first worked for Air France KLM as statistician before pursuing her career at Google as search Quality analyst and then Strategist at the trust and safety department.

## Any recommendation to work for a digital company?

First, don't be shy! Big digital companies have a lot of entry level positions and you don't need 5+ years of experience to join Google. Do the research and prepare for the interviews. During the interviews, try to answer questions providing concrete examples, make sure you understand the question and ask for clarification if you don't, remember that in most of the cases there are no "right" or "wrong" answers: questions are meant to reveal how new grads think through various issues
