# **Aims and Scope**

The objective of this conference, organized by the Toulouse School of Economics, is to bring together researchers working in the field of the economics of education, to present and discuss their research. The conference will welcome two keynote speeches, 6 to 8 contributed sessions (2 papers in each) and no parallel session. We will invite discussants for papers in the contributed sessions (we aim for presentations of about 35 minutes per paper + 15 minutes for discussion and questions).

#### **Research Themes**
